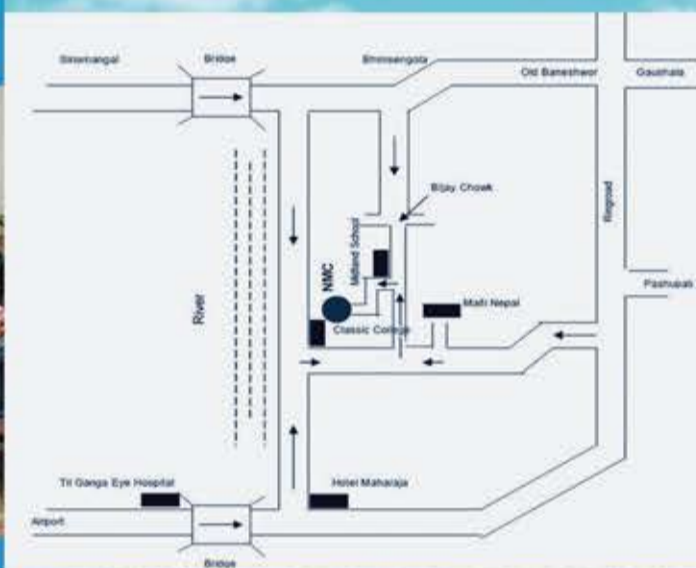

Nepal Sangeet Vidhyalaya (NSV) a music school established in the year 2006 in a custom-built premise with a forward looking curriculum based on music making in small groups, vocal/instrumental tuition, and aspects of understanding music.

NSV aims to provide formal education in music from the primary level onwards. It is probably the first ever Nepalese music school established with the due permission from the ministry of Education, with the given responsibility of developing a formal music curriculum from class one-ten which has been adopted by the government of Nepal.

- Extracurricular music school for young people

NSV provides structured courses for aspiring musicians. NSV offers classes in Nepali folk/ ethnic music, raga-based music and popular western forms like Classical, Blues, Jazz and Rock

- Scout and school for talented young musicians

A special intensive program has been developed to identify and nurture the musical development of students that show great promise in music, supported by scholarship grants. The students are groomed by qualified teachers and highly acclaimed artists within the county and outside.
